**This is a legal agreement between It's All About the Cats, Inc. (IAATCI) and the above described temporary foster home. The temporary foster home hereby acknowledges that:**

- 1. The temporary foster home has requested assistance from IAATCI to find an adoptive home for cat(s) they have rescued and/or personal cat(s) they can no longer keep;**
- 2. Everyone who "works" for IAATCI is a volunteer and that their time is donated;**
- 3. IAATCI does not have a shelter and operates solely on foster homes. At NO time should the foster home expect or presume that IAATCI will take cats that the foster home can no longer foster.** If circumstances arise that the foster home can no longer care for the cats, they agree to make other arrangements.
- 4. IAATCI has the right to cancel this agreement at any time** should there be a breach of any condition listed below. If such cancellation occurs, the temporary foster home agrees to reimburse IAATCI for all expenses incurred.

## **Conditions of this Temporary Foster Care Agreement**

The temporary foster home agrees to:

1. Provide food, water, exercise and shelter in a secure location – the cat(s) will not be allowed to roam outside.
2. Cooperate with IAATCI volunteers to obtain medical treatments needed to qualify the cat(s) for "available for adoption" status. This includes:
  - Transporting cat(s) to medical appointments,
  - Administering medications provided by IAATCI if so directed,
  - Pre-paying a "deposit" for medical treatments for any stray cat that the foster home is considering to keep as a personal pet (at the discretion of the board of directors), and
  - Following IAATCI policy regarding requests for veterinary care, as follows:
    - \* Non-emergency veterinary care **must** be scheduled through the IAATCI volunteers. The temporary foster home will be responsible for paying for any exams, tests or treatments that are not scheduled by the IAATCI volunteer.
    - \* Emergency veterinary care should be pre-approved through the IAATCI volunteers if possible. If time is of the essence, the foster home may take the cat(s) to an emergency care clinic but they will be responsible for the charges. Such expenses can be submitted to the IAATCI board of directors who will consider reimbursement.
3. Cooperate with IAATCI volunteers in the placement of the cat(s). This includes:
  - Meeting with potential adopters at a location to be determined on a case-by-case basis,
  - Scheduling all "available for adoption" status cat(s) for at least two adoption event per month, and
  - Transporting the cat(s) to and from adoption events as scheduled.
4. Reimburse IAATCI for all medical costs incurred by the organization under two conditions: (a) the temporary foster home decides to withdraw the cat(s) from the program or (b) IAATCI cancels the agreement.
5. Maintain proactive contact with the IAATCI volunteers. This includes checking email on a regular basis and responding to email in a timely manner as appropriate. If internet access is not available, it is the responsibility of the foster home to proactively contact the IAATCI volunteers via the voicemail system unless otherwise directed – the phone number is 407-401-8630.
6. Abide by all applicable city, county or state laws pertaining to animals.
7. Release and waive from liability or responsibility It's All About the Cats, Inc., its Board of Directors, and/or any employees and volunteers thereof, in the event that any damages to person or property are caused either directly or indirectly by fostered cat(s).
8. Respect the time and efforts donated by the IAATCI volunteers.
